MEMORANDUM

To: Wisconsin AAPM Members
From: William G. Connor
Subject: Establishment of a Wisconsin Area Chapter of the AAPM

On November 11, 1970, several members of the AAPM (W.G. Connor, J. R. Cameron, C. A. Kelsey, J. M. Hevezl, H. Hansen and K. P. Doppke) held an informal meeting to discuss the desirability and feasibility of establishing a Wisconsin Regional Chapter of the AAPM. It was decided that this might be desirable and the Wisconsin Members of the AAPM are therefore being contacted to solicit their views. This is the purpose of this memorandum and I would appreciate receiving your comments as soon as possible.

The next step in the procedure will be to form an Ad-Hoc Organization Committee to contact the AAPM Regional Organization Committee and draft a constitution for our Regional Chapter. MEMORANDUM

TO: Medical Physicists in Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa and the Dakotas
FROM: John R. Cameron

A group of us have decided there is merit in having an AAPM Chapter in this area. We suggest that we call it the North Central Chapter. (It covers the same states as the North Central Chapter of the HPS.) If you are interested in joining this proposed chapter, please return the enclosed application blank. I would expect the dues to be approximately \$5/year and that we would have a half or full day meeting once or twice a year--perhaps in conjunction with the NC-HPS chapter or the Midwest AAPM chapter meeting.

If we get at least 10 full members we will draft a set of by-laws based on those of other AAPM chapters and circulate them for comment. This memo is being sent to those individuals in the attached list.

If you know of other interested applicants please invite them to join. You do not have to be an AAPM member to belong to the chapter.

Your comments and suggestions would be welcome. If you are willing to be active as an officer or on the Board of the new chapter, please check the appropriate space.

Minutes of Proposed North Central Chapter of the AAPM (NC-AAPM)

An organizational meeting was held in the Blackstone Hotel on 28 November 1973 commencing at 1:00 P.M. with John Cameron serving as temporary Chairman. The following individuals were present: R. J. Boge, P. N. Deluca, G. D. Fullerton, R. G. Lane, V. C. Moore, A. L. Orvis, B. R. Paliwal, J. T. Payne, J. R. Tague and C. R. Wilson. Ray Tague was also present for a short while during the meeting. John Cameron asked how the members wished to have the meeting run; they agreed to have him chair the meeting.

There was a discussion of the proposed constitution and by-laws of the NC-AAPM. Al Orvis proposed that the nominating committee should be required to submit two names for each position. This was agreed upon unanimously.

There was a brief discussion of the geographical bounds of the NC-AAPM. It was pointed out that there are not strict rules on this matter and any AAPM member can join any chapter he wishes. It was generally felt that Iowa should be added to the list of states covered by the NC-AAPM since we have received membership applications from two medical physicists in Iowa and it is not clear that there are any other members in that state.

John Cameron reported that our application to be a chapter of the AAPM had been submitted several weeks earlier to the AAPM Regional Chapter Committee. The committee had not yet made a decision but there seemed little doubt that we would have no problems being approved.

Cameron pointed out that 35 individuals had applied for membership and of these 26 are full or junior members of the AAPM.

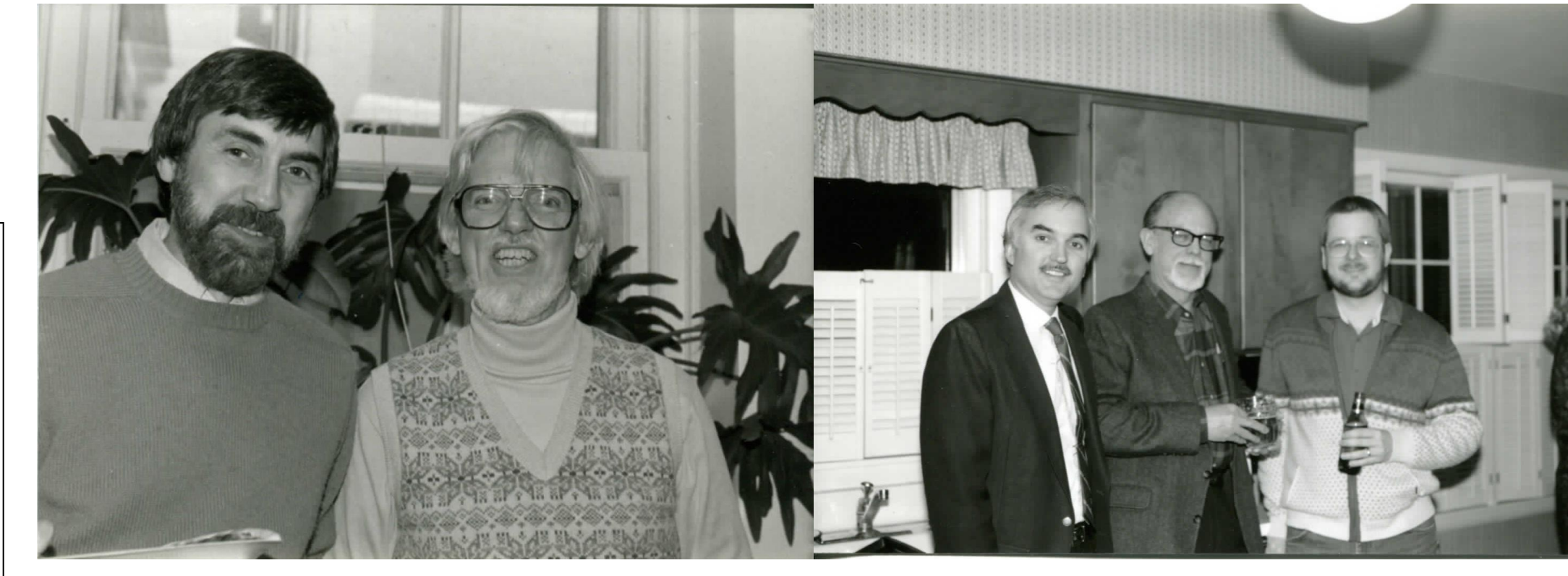
Cameron suggested that an appropriate time and place for the first meeting of the new chapter would be Madison, Wisconsin on the morning of April 5, 1974. The NC Chapter of the Health Physics Society will be meeting in Madison that afternoon and we could thus have an NC-AAPM Scientific meeting in the morning and an NC-HPS Scientific meeting in the afternoon. The details of the program and business meeting were left to an ad hoc committee which will also serve as the nominating committee. This committee is: Al Orvis, Vaughn Moore and John Cameron. This committee is to make nominations for the various offices and to arrange the election by mail ballot before April 5, 1974.

There was a brief discussion of dues but since no money is needed at this time it was decided to postpone this matter until April 5.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 1:50 P.M.
