Minutes of Proposed North Central Chapter of the AAPM (NC-AAPM)

An organizational meeting was held at the Blackstone Hotel on 28 November 1973 commencing at 2:00 p.m. with John Cameron serving as temporary Chairman. The following individuals were present: K. J. Joga, F. M. Deiana, G. D. Patterson, R. G. Lane, V. C. Moore, A. L. Geras, S. B. Palibroda, J. T. Payne, J. R. Tenor and C. A. Wilson. Roy Jamer was also present for a short while during the meeting. John Cameron asked how the members wished to have the meeting; they agreed to have the chair the meeting.

There was a discussion of the proposed constitution and by-laws of the NC-AAPM. An Davis proposed that the nominating committee should be required to submit two names for each position. This was agreed upon unanimously.

There was a brief discussion of the geographical bounds of the NC-AAPM. It was pointed out that there are not strict rules on this matter and any AAPM member can join any chapter he wishes. It was generally felt that Iowa should be added to the list of states covered by the NC-AAPM since we have received membership applications from two medical physicists in Iowa and it is not clear that these are any other states members in that state.

John Cameron reported that our application to be a chapter of the AAPM had been submitted several weeks earlier to the AAPM Regional Chapter Committee. The committee had not yet made a decision but there seemed little doubt that we would have no problems being approved.

Cameron pointed out that 35 individuals had applied for membership and of these 26 are full or junior members of the AAPM.

Cameron suggested that an appropriate time and place for the first meeting of the new chapter would be Madison, Wisconsin on the morning of April 5, 1974. The NC Chapter of the Health Physics Society will be meeting in Madison that afternoon and we could then have an NC-AAPM scientific meeting in the morning and a NC-AAPM Scientific meeting in the afternoon. The details of the program and business meeting were left to the ad hoc committee which will also serve as the nominating committee. This committee has: Al Onda, Young Moore and John Cameron. This committee is to make nominations for the various offices and to accept the election by mail before April 5, 1974.

There was a brief discussion of dues but since no money is needed at this time it was decided to postpone this matter until April 5.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 1:50 P.M.
